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High Peak Riding Club Advanced Dressage Clinic with Janet Knapp

To be held at Hargate Hill Equestrian Centre, Glossop, SK13 6JL on Sunday 16th April 2017.

We are pleased to be running our first advanced dressage clinic with Janet Knapp. Janet has competed for many years at Grand Prix level with her own horses and has a wealth of experience in judging and teaching dressage. This clinic is open to HPRC members and non-members. Novice and green horses are welcome, however to ensure you get the most from your lesson as riders you must be competent to ride at open prelim level. Each lesson is a private 45 minute lesson so horse and rider need to be at a reasonable level of fitness.

Lessons will commence at 9am. Finishing time will depend on the number of entries. This is the first clinic we have done for riders working and competing at a higher level so Janet has asked for private lessons to allow her to get to know the horse and rider combinations. If this clinic is successful, we may be able to structure this as semi-private lessons in the future.

Please can you give a few lines about the ability of you and your horse, what would you like to work on, what problems you encounter, what type of level you and your horse are working at and/or what previous dressage experience you have.

Dress code is casual riding gear with correctly fitted riding hats with the chin strap fastened. Spurs and whips are permitted in accordance with BD rules. Tack should also correspond to BD rules for the class / level you normal compete in. As of the 1st of January 2016 riding hats displaying only standards EN1384 and BSEN1384 only will no longer be acceptable to compete in or ride in as part of a club event. Acceptable standards can be found on the link below along with more information. Two of the most common acceptable standards that many of you will find inside your hats are PAS015 (1998 & 2011) or SNELL E2001). Some of the acceptable standards listed, may appear alongside EN1384 or BSEN1384 which is allowed, it is only when the EN1384 and BSEN1384 standard appear alone that you will not be allowed to use your hat in a riding club even. Hard hats (PAS015 & bsen1384) must be worn at all times when mounted. Body protectors are optional.

Please state if you are coming along/traveling with a friend of a similar level and would like to be given lessons consecutively so that we can try to accommodate your request. Any preference for slot time would also be useful in advance. Please ensure you are on time for you lesson as sessions will not be held for late comers.

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As the lessons are private, so slots are limited. Early entries are advised. If we are over-subscribed members will be given priority and will then be first come, first served basis. This decision will be made by the committee and will be final, however if we are running further clinics with Janet, member who do not get a place on the April clinic, will be given priority to enter the following clinic. Lesson times will be shared on the High Peak Riding Club Facebook page.

Please note – The club will not have access to the indoor arena and the event will be held in the outdoor arena as on previous occasions. We are conscious weather can become an issue. If it is deemed by the committee and / or Janet that it is unsafe to run the clinic for this reason we will let people know asap (E.g. frozen ménage, snow). In the event of this happening, we will refund your entry. However, if you decide not to attend due to weather and the event is still running we will be unable to refund entries.

The closing date for entries is Tuesday 11th April 2017.
